1. What character trait are you most known for and why?

2. What character traits, attitudes, and behaviors do you think are important for a follower of Christ to exhibit? Why these specific traits?

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3. Read Colossians 3:5-11. In what ways are the sins listed in verse 5 destructive in human lives?

4. Why does Paul equate greed with idolatry? What do we worship when we are greedy?

5. What happens when we flip-flop our priority and give it to possessions, not to God's kingdom? Why do possessions often seem more important than they are?

6. Which sins and attitudes of the old man are most accepted by the world today? Which are most difficult to leave behind? What is needed to have the discipline to put off the old man?

7. What is different about the new man, according to Paul in verse 10?

8. What barriers are represented in verse 11? How does our culture deal with them? Why should there be no barriers of segregation or prejudice among God's people?

9. Putting a sin or habit to death can be a process. What is the connection between renewing our minds and transforming our behaviors and actions?

10.Read Philippians 1:27-28. What good report did Paul want to hear about his friends in Philippi?

11. Why might the Philippian Christians have been in danger of disunity and poor conduct if Paul wasn't with them?



12. What does your life say about the priorities and values of your heart? Is the kingdom of God primary in your life? Are you focused on the temporary or the eternal? Explain.

13. What do you need to do to follow Jesus wholeheartedly and live worthy of the Gospel?
