5.	What was the danger facing the Colossians and who was Paul worried would delude them with persuasive arguments? Why did the nature of Paul's relationship with the church intensify this problem?
6.	Read John 14:6. How would you state this verse in your own words?
7.	What does it mean to say Jesus is the truth? How is this different than the world's definition of truth?
8.	How would you respond to someone who believes there are multiple ways to God or that truth is relative?
9.	Read John 3:16-18. What words from this passage help us understand the manner of God's love for us because of the Gospel?

10. Read Romans 5:6-11 and Ephesians 2:4-10. How does Paul describe the state of humanity and our need for Jesus?
11.Read Acts 4:12. Why does the truth about Gospel matter and why is our response about Jesus so important?
