Read Acts 8. What are some questions you have about this passage?

TRUTH TO LIVE BY

WHEN THE HOLY SPIRIT LEADS YOU, SAY 'YES' TO HIM (8:26-29)

1. Share a recent time the Holy Spirit led you. What did He lead you to do?
2. What are some of the ways the Holy Spirit leads us today?
Which ones are most effective for you? Why?

OUR HEAVENLY FATHER IS ALREADY DRAWING PEOPLE TO HIMSELF (8:30-34)

3. Who is someone in your life that you sense Jesus is drawing to Himself?
What makes you think this about that person? How did Jesus draw you to Himself?
4. What are some of the things Jesus does to draw people to Himself?

BE READY TO SHARE THE GOSPEL ACCURATELY (8:35)

5. What are the four 'facts' of the Gospel? Why are each important?
Take turns sharing the Gospel with each other right now.
6. Before sharing the Gospel with someone, it is wise to ask them first what they are trusting in for their salvation before you share the Gospel. Why?
7. Discuss: Two of the most important questions a person can be asked are:
"If you were to die, how sure are you that you'd go to heaven?" &
"If God asked you, 'Why should I let you into My heaven?' what would you say?"

ASK THE PERSON TO MAKE A DECISION TO TRUST JESUS ALONE (8:36-40)

8. Why is it so important you ask the person you are sharing the Gospel with to make a decision to repent of their sin & trust Jesus alone as their Savior?
9. Discuss: A good way to ask a person to make a decision to trust Jesus alone as their Savior is to ask them (after they understand the Gospel truths):
"Is there anything that would keep you from trusting Jesus alone right now as your Savior?" If they say "Yes", then talk about that. If they say "No" then encourage them to trust Jesus right now as their Savior.

Which of the above truths do you need to practice this next week? Why?
