Message Discussion Questions

Read Acts 22:30-23:11. What are some questions you have about this passage?

EXPLORE THE TEXT

- 22:30** The commander gathers the Jewish leaders to find out why Paul has been arrested & determine if this is a religious or civil matter.
- 23:1-5** What happens to Paul? What does Paul say? What do they say? Why?
- 23:6-8** What does Paul say that causes a problem amongst the Council? Why?
- 23:9-10** Why do the Pharisees side with Paul? Result of this?
- 23:11** Who comes and speaks with Paul? What does He say?

TRUTH TO LIVE BY

Question - What should we do in the face of “cancel culture”?

Share a time you were “cancelled” because of your being a Jesus-follower.

I. Jesus reveals Himself to believers in moments of crisis & difficulty

1. Share a time Jesus revealed Himself in a personal way during a hard time.
2. Why does Jesus come to us specifically in hard times? What’s His purpose?

II. Jesus is always with believers & He has a purpose and a plan

3. Read Romans 8:1-39—What do these verses say about Jesus’ presence?
4. Often our Father gives us a sense of His will in a situation, not specifics but just the big idea. Why? What do you do to “sense” the Father’s leading?

III. When being “cancelled”, believers are privileged to honor Jesus

5. The best way to honor Jesus is to love those who oppose Him and seek to share the Gospel with them. Share a time you had the privilege of doing this with someone.
6. Read 1 Peter 2:13-17. What words of encouragement does Peter give us?

IV. When being “cancelled”, keep Jesus supreme in everything

7. What does it mean to submit to Jesus’ Lordship in your life?
8. Living & speaking TRUTH in or with LOVE keeps Jesus supreme. Give an example.

V. When being “cancelled”, submit to God’s Word & His worldview

9. What is the difference between primary (major) & secondary (minor) issues?
10. How Biblical is your worldview? How do you? How can you make it more Biblical?

VI. When being “cancelled”, graciously support Biblical values

11. What does God’s Word say about - gender issues? Abortion? Poverty? Race?
12. When someone disagrees with you, how should you respond to them? Why?

Which of these 6 truths do you need to apply today? Why?
