Message Discussion Questions

Read Acts 26. What are some questions you have about this passage?

EXPLORE THE TEXT

- 26:1 What does King Agrippa tell Paul he can do?
- 26:2-11 What was Paul's life like before he became a Christian?
- 26:12-18 How did Paul become a Christian?
- 26:19-23 What was Paul's life like after he became a Christian?
- 26:24-29 How does Paul challenge King Agrippa?
- 26:30-32 What is King Agrippa's thoughts after Paul's defense? Why?

TRUTH TO LIVE BY

Since the Gospel is true & reasonable...

I. Be gracious. Read Colossians 4:6

- What does it mean to be gracious with those we are sharing Jesus with?
- Share a time Jesus enabled you to be gracious with someone you were seeking to share the Gospel of Jesus with.

II. Build bridges by finding common ground

- What are some bridges of common ground you can use with non-Christians you are seeking to be a witness to? Think of them as "open nerves" or sensitive areas of life that make a person open to having a change of life.

III. Share your faith story

- What is your faith story—how & when did you become a Christian?
- When sharing your faith story, think of it in three parts:
 1. What was my life like before I became a Christian—things that made me open to become a Christian?
 2. How did I become a Christian? How did I come to recognize I'm a sinner & needed God's forgiveness & that Jesus Christ died for my sins which led me to trust Jesus Christ alone as my Savior?
 3. How has Jesus been changing my life since I became a Christian?

IV. Stay focused on the most important issue at hand—the Gospel

- What are the main points/truths of the Gospel? See 1 Cor. 15:1-5
Read: Romans 3:23; 6:23; 5:8; 5:1; 10:9-10. Practice sharing the Gospel.

Which of these truths do you need to apply today? Why?
