TRUTHS TO DISCOVER - Read 1 Corinthians 5:1-13

*Why did Paul think it was not good for believers in a dispute to use the law courts to resolve their differences? (vs. 1-6)

*What things does he suggest they do instead? (vs. 2-8)

*What kind of people does Paul say will not inherit God's kingdom? (vs. 9-10)

*What does Paul say had happened to the Corinthian believers? (vs. 11)

*How did the change take place in their lives? (vs. 11) Was it a perfect change?

TRUTHS TO DISCUSS

1. Godly character really matters now & for eternity (6:1-11)

*What are some traits of godly character? Why is each one important? Biblical examples: James 3:17; 4:6; 5:7-9,16; Colossians 3:12-17

*What is one character trait that you would like to strengthen? Why?

2. Believers in Christ possess divine wisdom, power & character qualities that many in the world don't have (6:9-11)

*Which one of Paul's list of 9 qualities of unrighteousness surprises you? Why?

*What does Paul say was true of the Corinthian believers?

*What do non-Christians think when believers live like unbelievers?

3. Trust the spiritual leadership of your local church (6:4-6)

*Why is church membership important?

*Elders at Rockpoint have the responsibility to oversee the spiritual health of our church, while the Deacons are responsible for certain serving/care ministries. Why are both roles important?

4. Resolve disputes by practicing the character of Christ

*Read Romans 12:14-19; Ephesians 4:31-32 and Philippians 2:1-11
