1) Hebrews 4:12 says that the Word is alive and active. Discuss what this actually means. If the Word is alive what does that mean for our lives.

2) Have you ever read the Bible and felt like it was speaking to you? When was the last time you had a really good time in the Word? What was that experience like for you? What was so impactful about that experience?

3) John 1 connects the person of Christ with the God of Genesis 1. Why does John start his testimony of Jesus with the beginning of the universe? What does this mean about who Jesus is?

4) The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. Why was this necessary for Him to become a man? Is it necessary for Jesus to have had to hang on the cross?

5) God encouraged Joshua to be strong and courageous, to do what is written in the law and meditate on it day and night. Do you read the Word and listen to it like Joshua had to listen to the Lord?

6) Is your life marked by the Word; by faithfulness, by obedience, and by love?
