Sermon-based Growth Group Questions

Introductory Discussion:

What was "the takeaway" (the most important point) from Sunday's sermon and/or the sermon text, in your opinion?

What insight from Sunday's sermon did you find most helpful, or eye-opening, or troubling (pick any or all of the above)?

Read Romans 2:25-29

Discussion:

- 1. How is the intent of the law and of circumcision being twisted?
- 2. Did circumcision have value by itself alone 2:25? What else was needed? Explain.
- 3. From Deuteronomy 10:16; 30:6 and Jeremiah 4:4;9:25-26, what does Paul mean by "circumcision of the heart" (vs. 29)?
- 4. What is the real mark of the covenant community?
- 5. What religious rituals and symbols are twisted today like this?
- 6. Paraphrase what Paul is saying in verses 25-29, using the Christian symbol of baptism.
- 7. How does circumcision help us understand the gospel?
- 8. Just like some Jews found purpose and meaning in their ability to follow God's law, where are you tempted to find purpose, affirmation, or belonging in something other than God?
