Sermon-based Growth Group Questions

Introductory Discussion:

What was "the takeaway" (the most important point) from Sunday's sermon and/or the sermon text, in your opinion?

What insight from Sunday's sermon did you find most helpful, or eye-opening, or troubling (pick any or all of the above)?

Read Romans 3:1-8

Discussion:

- 1. What advantages did you gain by being brought up in your area of the country and in your particular home? What disadvantages did you face?
- 2. Why do you think it's easier to identify the things we don't have than to be thankful for, and recognize the things we do have?
- 3. From verses 1 & 2, what value does Paul place on being a Jew? In other words, prior to Paul writing Romans, what advantage did the Jews have?
- 4. How long have you been studying God's Word? What responsibility do you think comes with having access and understanding of God's Word? How have you demonstrated faithfulness to this responsibility?
- 5. Why do you think we blame God when things don't go our way? What does blaming God reveal about our beliefs concerning Him?
- 6. Read Psalm 51:1-4. Why is our sin against others ultimately sin against God?
- 7. What are some ways we diminish the sinfulness of our sin?
- 8. How have you encountered people twisting God's teachings for their own use? How did you respond?
