Discussion:

- 1. What is Paul's point in stressing that Abraham was counted as right with God before He was circumcised?
- 2. What promise was mentioned to Abraham in Romans 4:13?
- 3. Why is the Law unable to help a person become a child of Abraham?
- 4. How does a person become an heir to Abraham?
- 5. How does 4:9-15 illustrate what is said in 3:27-28?
- 6. Since this right relationship is a gift, how would you use Abraham's example to argue against a presumptuous attitude before God?
- 7. According to verse 11, what was the purpose of Abraham's circumcision? In other words, did his circumcision cause his righteousness or signify his righteousness? Explain the difference.
- 8. What types of New Testament religious signs might be similar to that of Old Testament circumcision? In other words, what types of signs signify one is a Christian but do not cause one to be a Christian?
- 9. If you are not a Jew by birth, why is today's text especially important to you?
