Introductory Discussion:

What was “the takeaway” (the most important point) from Sunday’s sermon and/or the sermon text, in your opinion?

What insight from Sunday’s sermon did you find most helpful, or eye-opening, or troubling (pick any or all of the above)?

Read Romans 9:30-10:4

Discussion:

1. In what characteristic way did Jews seek to be right with God? From 3:20 and 7:7-11, what was the basic problem with this approach? How do you see people trying this same way today?
2. On the basis of 10:1-2, how would you respond to someone who said, “What you believe doesn’t matter as long as you are sincere”? How can zeal for God sometimes get in the way of knowing Him?
3. If a friend asked you to explain the difference between Christianity and other religions, how would 9:30-31 help you answer?
4. How would I describe Paul’s attitude toward unsaved Jews (Romans 10:1)? How is my attitude toward unbelievers similar or different? How can I increase my burden for the lost?
5. Who am I currently praying for that needs Jesus? What am I prepared to do about it?
