Sermon-based Growth Group Questions

Introductory Discussion:

What was “the takeaway” (the most important point) from Sunday’s sermon and/or the sermon text, in your opinion?

What insight from Sunday’s sermon did you find most helpful, or eye-opening, or troubling (pick any or all of the above)?

Read Romans 10:5-10:13

Discussion:

1. How would the attitude of a person coming to God on the basis of his or her performance (v.5) be different from that of someone coming to Him by faith in Christ (vv.8-9)?
2. What does it mean to confess “Jesus is Lord”? How would you illustrate this from earlier chapters in Romans? How does this tie in with belief?
3. Look at 3:23-28: How does the phrase “there is no difference,” in that context compare with its use here in 10:12? What hope is given here?
4. What is one major way your confession of Christ as Lord has influenced your life?
5. The central affirmation of the early church was “Jesus is Lord”; everyone else was saying “Caesar is Lord.” Who or what are some gods that compete with your allegiance to Christ?
