Introductory Discussion:

Discussion:

- 1. When you were growing up, what authority figure was toughest for you to respect? Why?
- 2. In light of Paul's teaching about freedom in Christ, why might this section be important for the church in Rome? How does he view government in relationship to God?
- 3. How are government leaders seen as God's servants? How does this section challenge the world's view of relating to governing authorities?
- 4. Compare this passage with Acts 5:27-32. What overriding principles do you find in these passages for guiding the Christian's relationship to authority?
- 5. Read 1 Peter 2:13-17. How do the verbs in verse 17 help define what Peter means by submission?
- 6. How should your relationship to God influence how you deal with human authority?
- 7. If you were traveling to a place where you had no protection from harassment as a Christian, how would this passage shape your response?
