Sermon-based Growth Group Questions

Introductory Discussion:

What was “the takeaway” (the most important point) from Sunday’s sermon and/or the sermon text, in your opinion?

What insight from Sunday’s sermon did you find most helpful, or eye-opening, or troubling (pick any or all of the above)?

Read Romans 13:8-14

Discussion:

1. What are your favorite clothes? “Wear” did you get them? How do you feel and act when you wear them?
2. From verses 8-10, how does the law help us know what it means to love? How does this differ from what it means to many people today?
3. How do verses 13-14 spell out his light and darkness theme (v.12)?
4. What does the “clothing” of verse 14 mean in practical terms for you? How would you use this section to explain what holiness is all about?
5. How would your life be different today if you had consciously tried to act out the character of Jesus? What will you have to change to ensure you can play the part better?
6. When have you been asleep in your faith? How did you wake up?
7. If Christ were to come back at the end of your growth group meeting, what would you say to those in your group?
