Discussion:

2. Why does Paul want his Gentile readers to be aware of God's plan here? Why might pride become a

danger to them?

3. How would you paraphrase God's purpose in verses 25-26 and verses 30-31? How would this diffuse

tensions between the two groups?

4. What is the ultimate hope for Israel (v. 26-27)? For Gentiles (v. 32)? How does this tie in to Paul's

teaching in 3:21-24?

5. When have you been conceited about yourself or your faith? How has God dealt with this conceit?

6. How has God's mercy towards others spurred you on in faith?

7. What attributes of God does Paul celebrate here? Why these? How are any unanswered questions that

may be raised by chapters 9-11 quieted by the Old Testament quotes in verses 33-36?

8. Why is this a good place for a doxology, Paul's and yours?
