Sermon-based Growth Group Questions

Introductory Discussion:

What was "the takeaway" (the most important point) from Sunday's sermon and/or the sermon text, in your opinion?

What insight from Sunday's sermon did you find most helpful, or eye-opening, or troubling (pick any or all of the above)?

Read Romans 16:17-27

Discussion:

- 1. How might Paul's concern in 17-20 be reflected in the issues he has dealt with in 3:8, 6:1,15, 7:7 and 9:4 (See also Galatians 5:2-6)?
- 2. How are these false teachers contradicting Paul's main point about serving Christ (v. 18, see 14:17-18)?
- 3. What do verses 25-27 show you about the purpose and plan of God throughout history?
- 4. What are some of the teaching that are dividing the church today? How do you work for balance between a desire for unity and a desire to maintain truth?
- 5. What does it mean to you that in these final chapters God is described as the "God of hope" (15:13) and the "God of peace" (15:33, 16:20)? How would you sum up how it is we can know God like this, especially when Paul started this letter by showing us the God of wrath?
- 6. What will you do to increase your participation in God's plan to lead all nations to believe and obey Him? Do you view this task more as a grim duty or as a tremendous privilege? What does this show about your heart attitude toward the Gospel?
