Introductory Discussion:

What from Sunday’s sermon did you find most helpful, or eye-opening, or troubling (pick any or all of the above)?

Discussion:

1. **How does knowing that He is risen, that you are forgiven, change how you look at what is happening in your life?**
 - a. **How does the fact that you are eternal change how you live your life, your priorities?**

2. **What are your refuges? Where do you go to feel safe when life is difficult?**
 - a. **Why is Jesus a better hiding place?**

3. **The disciples realized it was Jesus only after they broke bread. In communion, what does the bread represent?**
 - a. **This symbolically links participating in the crucifixion (by consuming the bread) is how we come to know Him. In what ways does understanding the crucifixion open our eyes to who Jesus really is?**
 - b. **Why is seeing ourselves crucified with Him important?**

4. **The two disciples realized later that when He spoke that their hearts burned within them. Why is it useful to look back at God working in your life in the past, even before you believed?**
 - a. **How can that knowledge help you in the future?**

5. **When did God open your eyes and what was it like?**

- 6. Jesus joined the disciples on their journey and revealed things to them and then revealed Himself. What is your process for getting to know Jesus?**

- 7. Why does Jesus act like He is going farther?**
 - a. He puts the disciples in a position of asking Him to stay. Why is that significant?**
 - b. What does the fact that they asked Him to stay mirror the process of getting to know Him?**

- 8. What is it about your story of faith that someone needs to hear?**
