Sermon-based Growth Group The Gospel of John: Healing at Bethesda John 5:1-17 Questions July 24, 2022

Introductory Discussion: What from Sunday's sermon did you find most helpful, or eye-opening, or troubling (pick any or all of the above)?

Discussion:

- 1. In verse 6, Jesus asks the man if he wants to be healed. What are some reasons that someone would NOT want to be healed?
 - a. What are the consequences of accepting His healing?
 - b. Are we sometimes concerned that He won't heal us the way we want to be healed?
- 2. Where do you look when you need help?
 - a. Is Jesus your first step to getting better or your last step?
- 3. The Pharisees ignored the fact that a man was just healed and focused on the fact that it was the Sabbath. Can you think of a time when you missed what God was doing because he didn't do it the way you expected?
 - a. Are the rules or your expectations about God and how He works helping you or getting in the way of seeing Him working in your life?
- 4. In verse 14, Jesus says, "See, you are well! Sin no more, that nothing worse may happen to you." Which is the more important healing, the man's body or his soul?
 - a. Jesus tells the man to walk to show that he is physically healed, but how does "walking" help the man to "sin no more" (see Galatians 5:16-17, 1 John 2:6)?
