Introductory Discussion: What from Sunday's sermon did you find most helpful, or eye-opening, or troubling?

1. Why is humility necessary to approach God?
2. What is omnipotence?
3. What is the concern about how God can be omnipotent and yet there is evil in the world?
  - a. What mistake does one make when one assumes that God is either impotent or evil because there is evil in the world?
  - b. What can we learn from accepting that we know that God can stop evil, but we don't know why he doesn't?
4. If God is omnipotent what does that mean about his ability to meet your needs?
  - a. So, if it seems that God is not meeting your needs, how do many people wrongly interpret it?
  - b. How should we interpret it?
5. According to Philippians 4:5-7, what should you do that can help you be at peace?
6. Grudem says that God is the final standard of what is just. How does it help us to understand what justice really is to know that God himself is the definition?
  - a. If we see God do something that seems unjust, should we conclude that God is unjust, or that our understanding of justice is flawed?
  - b. How can we use these moments to better understand justice and who God is?
7. How can this knowledge of God's omnipotence and justice change the way we live?
