 - b. Who separates from whom?
 - c. How do we fix it?
2. What does omniscient mean?
3. Does the fact that God knows everything about you comfort you or concern you?
4. How can the fact that God knows everything, past, present, and future, be comforting?
 - a. For this to be comforting, why is it important to know that He loves you?
 - b. What is God’s purpose in revealing your hidden sin and faults?
5. If God already knows what we need, how should that change the way we live?
 - a. What does it mean when we don’t seem to be getting what we “need?”
6. To whom does God show mercy?
 - a. Since we will struggle in our lives, why is it important to know that God is merciful?
7. Grace is the goodness of God to those who deserve punishment. How should we respond to his grace?

- a. How hard is it for you to accept that there is nothing you did or can do to earn salvation?
- b. If we have already been saved and there is nothing we can do to earn it, why be good?
