 - a. Does your giving cost you? Do you feel it?
- 7. In Luke 14:12-14, Jesus says to invite the poor, not the rich, to your party. What are the selfish reasons to invite the well-to-do?
 - a. What is the spiritual reason to invite those who don't benefit you?

- 8. What do we mean when we say, "you can't take it with you"?
 - a. What perspective should that give us about material wealth?
 - b. In what way does helping those in need mean we can "take it with us"?
