  - b. What does verse 13 say about exposing darkness?
  
7. In one word, what does verse 15 say to do?
  - a. What does verse 16 say to do?
  
  - b. What does verse 17 say not to do?
  
  - c. If we walk in the light, make the most of our time, and not be foolish, what does verse 17 say we will understand?
