  - a. What does that tell us about God's promises?
  - b. How can we live as though we really believe the promises of God?
- 5. What is God's promise in Romans 8:28-3-30?
  - a. Give an example of how that might affect your decision making in this world?
- 6. Looking back at Genesis and Exodus shows that God is always working out his \_\_\_\_\_\_.
  - a. What does that tell us about how God works?
  - b. How should we respond when it doesn't seem like God is doing anything, or that things are not happening fast enough?
- 7. How do you see the gospel in the Israelites through Genesis and into Exodus?
