 - a. How have you seen God work in your life?
 - b. How can remembering that help you now?

3. God told Adam to fill the earth. How are we expected to fill the earth now?
4. God promises Abraham and then Jacob to make them a great nation. Did this happen?
 - a. What does that tell us about God’s promises?
 - b. How can we live as though we really believe the promises of God?
5. What is God’s promise in Romans 8:28-30?
 - a. Give an example of how that might affect your decision making in this world?
6. Looking back at Genesis and Exodus shows that God is always working out his _____.
 - a. What does that tell us about how God works?
 - b. How should we respond when it doesn’t seem like God is doing anything, or that things are not happening fast enough?
7. How do you see the gospel in the Israelites through Genesis and into Exodus?
