 - a. Can we obey the laws of the land in a way that honors God?
- 3. What does it teach us about how God works that Moses is saved by Pharaoh's daughter?
 - a. If God is in control, what do we need to do to achieve the right outcome?
- 4. Did Moses's mother know why all this was happening?
 - a. Do we need to know what God is going to do in order to trust him?
 - b. How do we handle the uncertainty?
- 5. What does it teach us that Moses's parents had to give him up to be raised by Egyptians?
 - a. What other things in our lives do we need to let go of so that God can use them for his purposes?
- 6. Who ends up nursing Moses for Pharaoh's daughter?
 - a. What might that teach us about what God does when we give up something or someone for Him?
 - b. What might you need to let go of in order for it to be a blessing from God?
