“The Gospel in Exodus: Trusting Faith”
Exodus 2:1-10
May 19, 2024

Introductory Discussion: What from the sermon did you find most helpful, or eye-opening, or challenging?

1. How was hiding Moses an act of faith by his parents (read Hebrews 11:1 and 23)?
 - a. How does this reflect James 2:17?

2. How did Moses’s mother honor Pharaoh’s command?
 - a. Can we obey the laws of the land in a way that honors God?

3. What does it teach us about how God works that Moses is saved by Pharaoh's daughter?
 - a. If God is in control, what do we need to do to achieve the right outcome?

4. Did Moses’s mother know why all this was happening?
 - a. Do we need to know what God is going to do in order to trust him?
 - b. How do we handle the uncertainty?

5. What does it teach us that Moses’s parents had to give him up to be raised by Egyptians?
 - a. What other things in our lives do we need to let go of so that God can use them for his purposes?

6. Who ends up nursing Moses for Pharaoh's daughter?
 - a. What might that teach us about what God does when we give up something or someone for Him?
 - b. What might you need to let go of in order for it to be a blessing from God?
